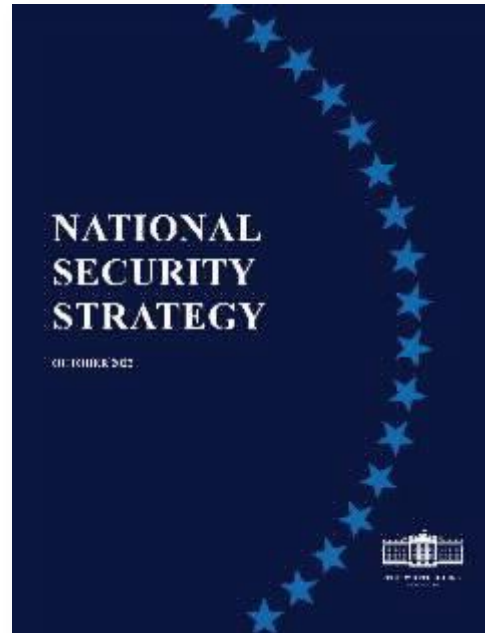
MISSION, VISION, VALUES

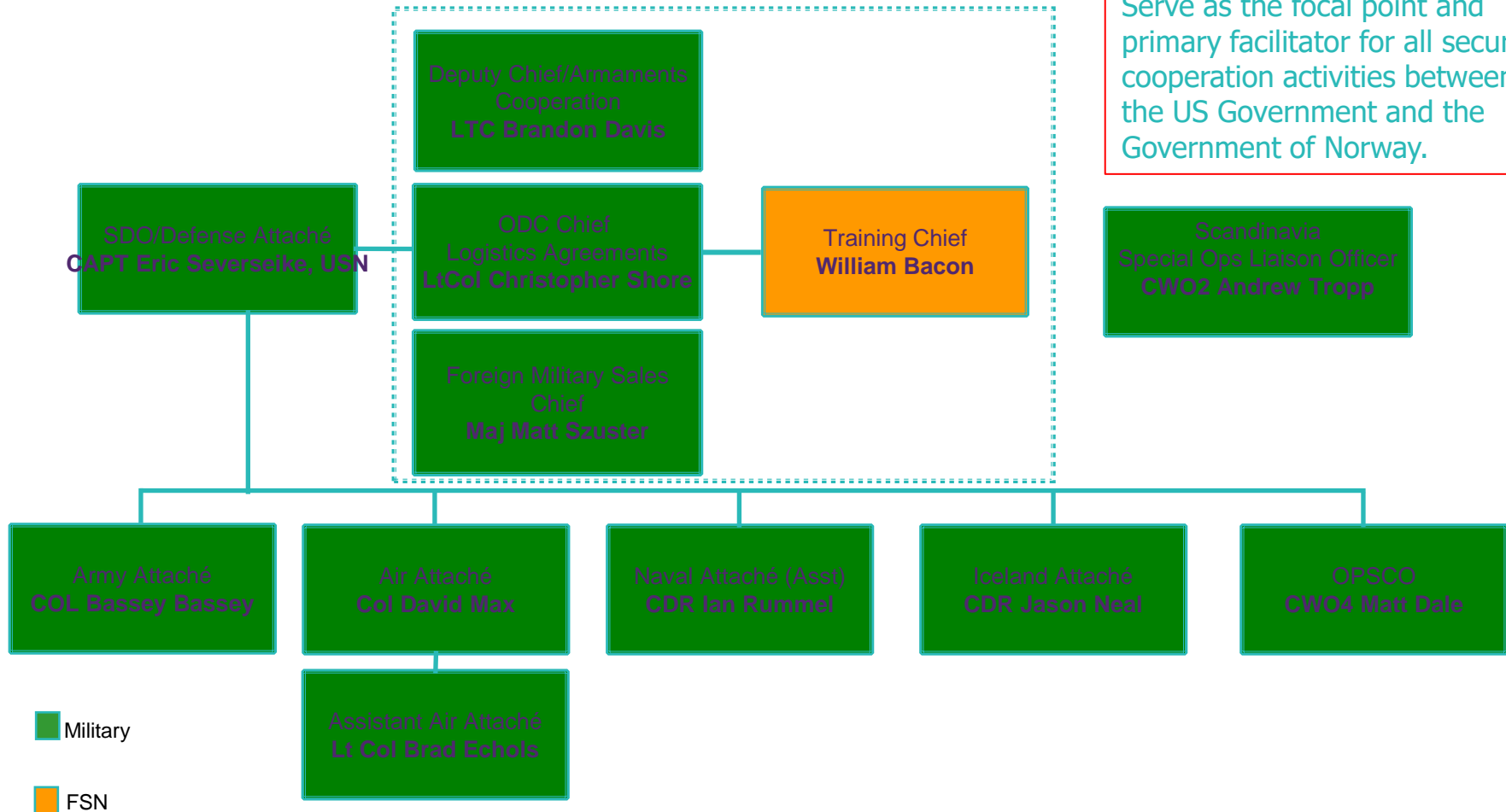

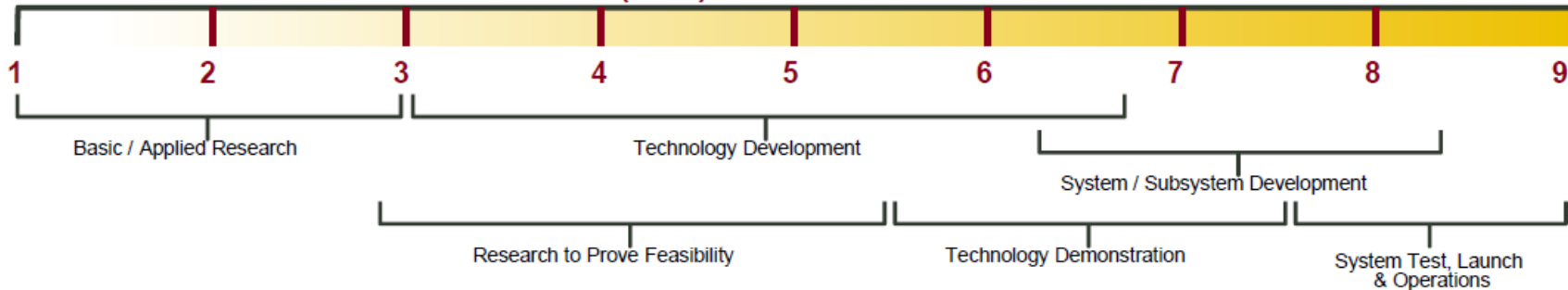

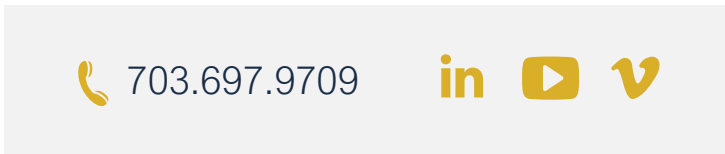
